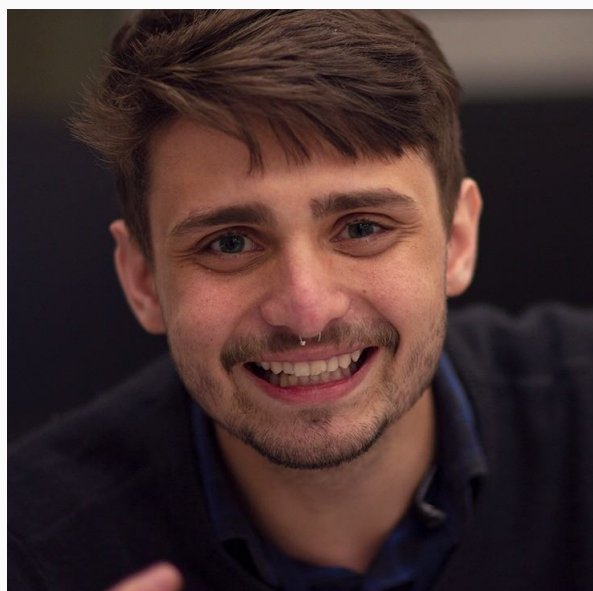

From 2023 to now - 2 years

Initially hired as a UI/UX designer, I quickly saw the necessity and opportunity to take on the frontend development of my team. This opportunity led me to learn a lot, gain confidence in turning layouts into code while also improving my design skills.

In April 2024 I was promoted to mid-level frontend developer, officially assuming the frontend development as my main role, while also still making some UX tasks and supervising a Junior designer in UI tasks.

During my time in Riote I worked in 2 main projects, a videoconference web application for legislative chambers and a legislative process manager (ERP). Acting as a frontend and UX designer in both.
